There are still many trucks, digging in the streets, grinding of pavement, a few road closures and restrictions from parking on the roads the next few weeks around the north end to downtown. We will attempt to finish paving P St from Lincoln Ave to the alley between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> St on Friday May 22. On Tuesday and Wednesday May 26 and May 27 we will be paving I St from 5<sup>th</sup> St south to 15<sup>th</sup> St. We will still be working on underground utilities on J street for a couple more weeks. Your trash and compost totes will be picked up as normal but could be earlier or later than usual so your totes must be out before 6 AM on trash day. Please be patient and avoid this area if you can go around another way on these days. Of course, weather is always a factor, so this schedule is tentative, as we have ran into rain the past weeks. We want the Contractor's employees, City of Bedford employees and the public safe. Watch for temporary road closures and go slow. We want to thank all the residences and businesses for their patience.
