- 1. Request Approval and Acceptance of Contract for Remediation Work at the Englewood Fire Station-Mayor Samuel J. Craig, Greg Pittman
- Mayor Craig said there is a health hazard with bird droppings at Englewood Fire Station.
- Blue Moose Environmental, LLC will perform remediation of bird droppings at the building located at 2415 29th Street.
- Remediation work will include, but is not limited to the following:
- Controls such as containment and HEPA air scrubbers will be put in place prior to the start of work, as needed, to prevent clean areas and /or contents from being contaminated.
- Fiberglass insulation will be removed form the ceiling in the garage/storage areas and metal ceiling beams and other surfaces will be cleaned, as necessary, with a disinfectant.
- Drop ceiling tiles throughout the living areas will be removed and disposed of. Surfaces and beams above the drop ceiling will be cleaned with a disinfectant, as necessary.
- Floor protection will be utilized in the living quarters, as necessary.
- All areas of the building will be cleaned with HEPA vacuum prior to finishing work.
- The total cost for remediation is \$13,900.00
- Work will begin on November 16, 2022 and will take 4-5 days to complete.
