- 1. **Request Acceptance** Of Bids For Video Equipment and Server Storage For Police Department and Parking Area for New Police Station Located at 2208 West 16<sup>th</sup> Street.-Chief Terry Moore.
  - Sent bid requests to three vendors
  - Received two bids & one letter of no bid
- Hicom Inc -From Greene Co \$82,912.36 with a \$2,000 contingency. Includes wiring. Quick response to bid.
- Security Automation Systems-From Indianapolis -\$73,050 with no contingency and no wiring. Slow to respond to bid
  - Estimated wiring \$2,000 to \$2,500 but some council members stated that was a very low estimate.
  - \$6,000 estimated difference if the contingency and wiring is considered.
  - The increased cost of bids is due to server size. Hicom is a larger company therefore the cost of the server is lower. Hicom gave the city a break in their cost of the server.
  - Cloud storage was discussed but would cost thousands.
  - Installation needs to begin before March 6th.

- The county quit using Security Automation Systems because of the lag time in answering calls for issues.
  - Ryan Griffith made the motion to approve bid from Hicom Inc,
  - Judy Carlisle seconded the motion,
  - All votes were in favor, No One opposed, Approved

#### 2. Request Acceptance Of Bid For Police Dispatch Furniture-Chief Terry Moore

- One bid was received, ask for more but have not received yet
- Need three bids
- Will be about four month lead time and timing is a concern.
- The generator and radio tower work will begin in March.
